Constitution

The *Space Renaissance International* ("SRI") Space Law Committee is constituted in the frame of the Space Renaissance Academy Space Development Laboratory.

Objective

The objective of the *Space Renaissance International* ("SRI") Space Law Committee is to provide the SRI community with an understanding of existing space law rules and principles to facilitate their beyond-Earth endeavors. In addition, the SRI Space Law Committee was established to assist in the further development of space law and policy, undertaking legal research and discussions at the intergovernmental, non-governmental, academic, and commercial levels to help ensure that space law continues to be a relevant part of international law, including building upon its economic, social and cultural foundations, as humanity ventures further and longer beyond Earth.
